George Bradford Hathaway, age 89, of Toledo's Point Place Community, passed away Tuesday, April 16, 2019 at his residence. He was born December 9, 1929 in Bucyrus, OH to Arthur and Marie (Frakes) Hathaway.

George was a 1947 graduate of Lyons High School in Lyons, OH.
